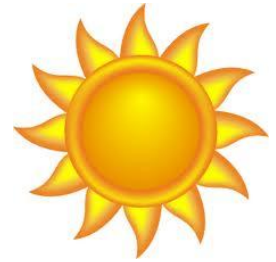


Top Ten Things To Remember For Day Camp Junior Counselors
